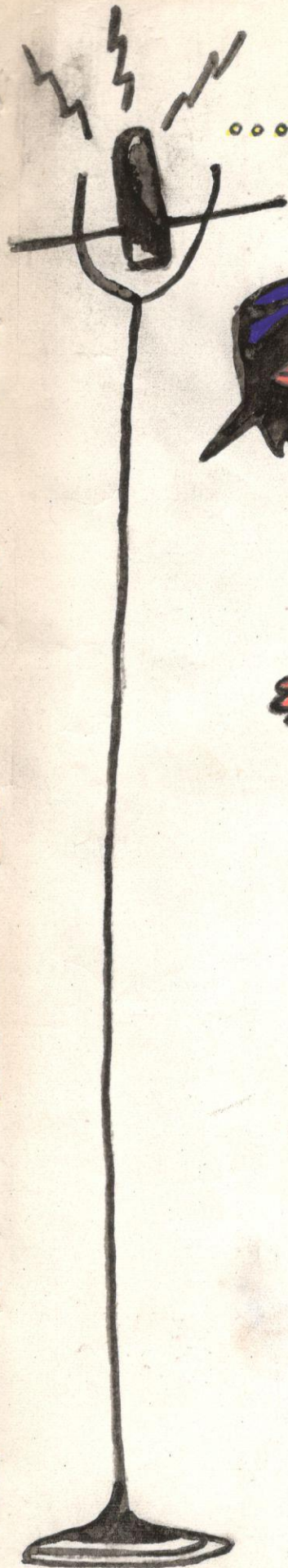

I have tried to make my rating system as simple as possible and also as fair as I possibly can. I have relistened to the opening and closing of every program that is listed and in many cases I have relistened to the entire show.

GE - Good to Excellent - Any collector should feel free to request any program with this rating. The show is as close to the original sound as possible.

G - Good. Any collector should also feel free to request any program with this rating. There might be a single skip or volume drop or some other very minor flaw which will not diminish the listening enjoyment of the show at all.

FG - Fair to Good. This one is a little tricky. What I mean is that there might be some static interference, a few skips, some volume dips, etc. The program is still good listening and is worth ordering.

F - Fair. Shows with this rating may have the same problems as mentioned above, but to a higher degree. The biggest problem here is fuzzy sound. If you want all of a given show and need this one, order it. Otherwise, pass it by.

FP - Fair to Poor. You will not be able to relax listening to this show. The sound may be distorted, there may be a whistle in the background, there may be some talk in the background or some other equally unpleasant problem. Don't request a show with this rating unless you are desperate.

P - Poor. If you want this show your collection is in trouble.

When ordering programs, I would appreciate it if you would list the show by number.

For example: If you want the Abbott and Costello Program, just request 34.1.1. This means that the show is on tape #34, the show is listed on page 1 and is my first show.

I hope that I have given enough information about each program so that there will be no question about which show is listed. I have left a space for dates, so that I might be able to fill them in in the future. If you can help me to fill them in or to correct any of my dated shows, I would be most appreciative.

I trade only two track and use 1800' Concert tapes. I have had pretty good luck with them. I use two Audiotronic 110 recorders for all of my work.

I hope that the last page might help some collectors to find shows with their favorite stars listed. Someday, I would like to have a complete index like this.
