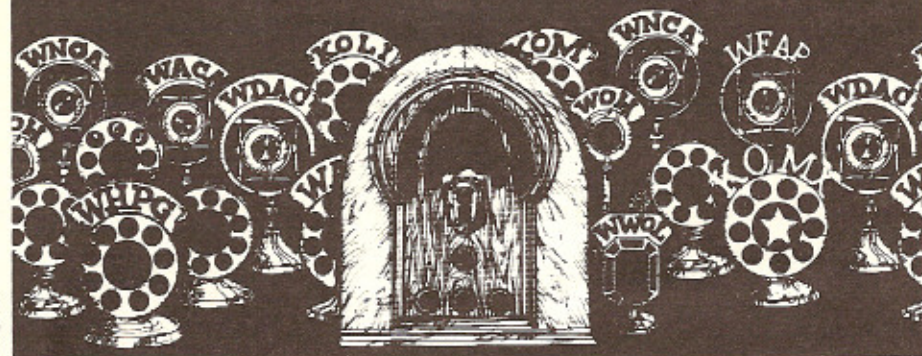


Collector's Corner
