TAPE TIPS (Mainly for beginners). 1. If you receive a tape which you feel has problems let the sender know. Often he has trouble with his machine and doesn't realize it. Any sincere trader will welcome comments...2. In order to save patchcord connections, especially if you constantly pull them in and out, buy a pair of short patchcords and insert them in one machine. Insert regular patchcords in other machine. Use the other ends of the short patchcords as point of entry for longer ones. 3. Periodically check speed of recorders with stroboscope. Some Clues: NBC chimes are C-A-F...Suspense chimes are G flat-F...Gunsmoke theme is in key of E flat. If you are musical this will help but a c tuning fork is all you need for the NBC chimes...
