BY UNKNOWN, I MEAN SUCH THINGS AS AMOS & ANDY SHOWS THAT NO ONE ELSE HAS AND ANY OTHER SHOWS NO OTHER COLLECTORS HAVE. I HAVE BEEN OFFERED QUITE A NUMBER OF DISCS AND OR COPIES OF DISCS ON TAPE. BECAUSE OF MY LIMITED RESOURCES I HAVE BEEN UNABLE TO BUY ALL THAT HAVE BEEN OFFERED. I THOUGHT THAT BY STARTING A CLUB YOU AND I MIGHT BE ABLE TO BUY DISCS AND KEEP THEM FROM BEING LOST FOR EVER.

I HAVE CERTAIN FAVORITE SHOWS, ESPECIALLY THE CHILDRENS SHOWS LIKE JACK ARMSTRONG CAPT MIDNIGHT, ORPHAN ANNIE, ETC ALSO SHERLOCK HOLMES WITH BASIL RATHBONE, I LOVE A MYSTERY, SAM SPADE, ETC, ETC. BUT AS YOU KNOW I AM INTERESTED IN MOST SHOWS AND IF I COULD AFFORD IT WOULD OWN ALL OF THEM.

SOME OF THE PEOPLE WHO HAVE CONTACTED ME HAVE GREAT SHOWS BUT THEY WANT TOO MUCH FOR THEM. ONE FELLOW SAID THAT HE HAS AN UNCIRCULATED CAPT. MIDNIGHT EPISODE IN PERFECT SHAPE AND HE WANTED \$20.00 FOR IT. THAT IS MUCH TOO HIGH FOR ONE PERSON TO PAY, BUT IF THERE WERE 20 OF US OR 40 OF US TO SPLIT THE COST WE COULD ALL AFFORD IT.

HERE IS THE PROPOSAL FOR THE CLUB:

SEND ME YOUR NAME AND ADDRESS AND AN INITIAL FEE OF \$2.50.

THIS FEE WILL BE USED TO ADVERTISE FOR DISCS. (I WAS SPENDING \$29.00 PER MONTH TO ADVERTISE WITH ONE NATIONAL MAGAZINE FOR DISCS, SO ADVERTISING IS EXPENSIVE.)

I WILL KEEP A LIST OF ALL MEMBERS AND WHEN A POTENTIAL LOT OF DISCS IS OFFERED TO ME WILL CONTACT YOU AND TELL YOU WHAT IS OFFERED AND WHAT IT WILL COST TO BUY THE DISCS. THEN IF YOU ARE INTERESTED YOU CAN SEND WHAT EVER YOUR PORTION WILL BE.

ONCE THE DISCS REACH ME THEY WILL BE COPIED ONTO TAPE BY ME OR IF THEY ARE IN TOO BAD A SHAPE I WILL SEND THEM TO AN ENGINEER FOR HIM TO MAKE COPIES. THEN A ROUND ROBIN TAPE WILL START OUT FROM HERE. EACH PERSON IN THE GROUP WILL COPY THE TAPE AND SEND IT TO THE NEXT PERSON UNTIL EVERYONE HAS HAD THE TAPE AND COPIED IT.

THE FLAWS IN THIS SCHEME ARE FAIRLY OBVIOUS. EACH PERSON WILL HAVE TO ONLY KEEP THE TAPE FOR A SHORT LENGTH OF TIME. OTHERWISE IT WILL NEVER MAKE THE ROUNDS. THE TAPE COULD BE LOST IN THE MAILS SO EACH PERSON WILL HAVE TO INSURE IT TO THE NEXT PERSON. IF A PERSON KEEPS A TAPE TOO LONG BEFORE PASSING IT ON TO THE NEXT PERSON HE WILL BE DROPPED FROM THE CLUB AND LOSE HIS INITIAL FEE AND THE CHANCE TO PARTICIPATE IN FURTHER CLUB PURCHASES. EVERY SO OFTEN THE FEES WILL RUN OUT AND WE WILL ASSESS CLUB MEMBERS SAY \$1.00 EACH. AS I SAID, THIS WILL GO FOR ADVERTISING, PRINTING, ETC. IF THE CLUB MEMBERS WISH, I WILL BE GLAD TO LIST THE MAGAZINES I HAVE ADVERTISED IN WITH CLUB MONEY. - YOU AS MEMBERS WILL BE EXPECTED TO ACTIVELY HUNT 16 INCH DISCS FOR THE CLUB TO BUY. IF YOU FIND A DISC OR TWO OF INTEREST AND WANT TO CONTRIBUTE THE SOUND OR THE DISC ITS SELF TO THE CLUB THIS WILL OF COURSE BE APPRECIATED AND THE SOUND PUT ON A TAPE AND SENT OUT OVER THE ROUND ROBIN. - I NEED TO HAVE YOUR THOUGHTS AND COMMENTS. HOW CAN YOU HELP OTHER THAN MONEY? I HAVE FOUND THAT THE PEOPLE YOU WOULD EXPECT TO HAVE DISCS OF THE SHOWS THEY WERE ACTORS ON USUALLY DONT. IT IS USUALLY THE ENGINEERS, OR JANITORS WHO TOOK HOME THE DISCS. SO ALK EVERYONE YOU KNOW IF THEY HAVE DISCS OR KNOW WHERE THERE ARE SOME. YOUR NEXT DOOR NEIGHBOR MAY HAVE 6 YEARS OF AMOS AND ANDY IN HIS ATTIC.
