STATIC FLUTTER & POP 2 is still available; it will cost 75¢ and this entitles you to a 15 (or so) page supplement correcting and expanding the data presented in SFP2. SFP2 is a 53-page, mimeographed magazine presenting detailed information on the science fiction plays on radio, except strictly juvenile shows. With network cooperation a complete log is presented of Dimension X, X Minus One, a partial list of 2000 Plus and CBS Radio Workshop, and information on Exploring Tomorrow, science fiction authors and many other shows. The supplement treats the ABC series, Tales of Tomorrow, provides more details on each of the above and discusses SF 68, Quiet Please and other shows as well as presenting the views of some actors, directors and writers concerning these programs. Several readers of SFP2 have contributed further information and their names and addresses are set forth in the supplement. 2 of these for \$1.35. ORDER TODAY.

SOUND CONDITION: The standard (subjective) grading symbols are used. vg, g/vg, g, f and p for poor. In addition, cross talk is noted "xt" and buzz is noted "b". Note: I specialize in Ray Bradbury stories and the name Bradbury or RB is frequently noted. ALSO where possible the subject matter is noted: s or sf for science fiction and h for horror.

TIME: If a program was intended as a half-hour by the network, that's the way I log it. Length is noted only if 15 minutes (1/4) or an hour or longer; all others are the nominal 30 minutes although they may vary from 20 minutes to 31. (I'll try to make up time with fillers).

THE PROGRAMS IN THIS LIST ARE FOR PRIVATE USE AND ARE AVAILABLE FOR TRADE ONLY. THEY ARE NOT CLEARED FOR RADIO BROADCAST OR OTHER COMMERCIAL USE, AND NO BROADCAST RIGHTS ARE STATED OR IMPLIED.

I have made an especial effort to be conservative in grading; most shows sent as vg have been regraded, some down to g! "g/vg" is the most general condition; these are in most acceptable quality, some parts may be better than others, minor flaws removable by your adjustments in listening equipment (hiss, etc)--not enough defects to distract the listener, in fact, enjoyable listening.

When no grade appears opposite a particular title, the grade is the general grade shown opposite the series title.

All catalogs are welcome--my only interests in collecting at present are in the science fiction and horror fields and material from other kinds of shows (or detective or straight crime shows) could be better sent to others, unless specifically ordered by me.
