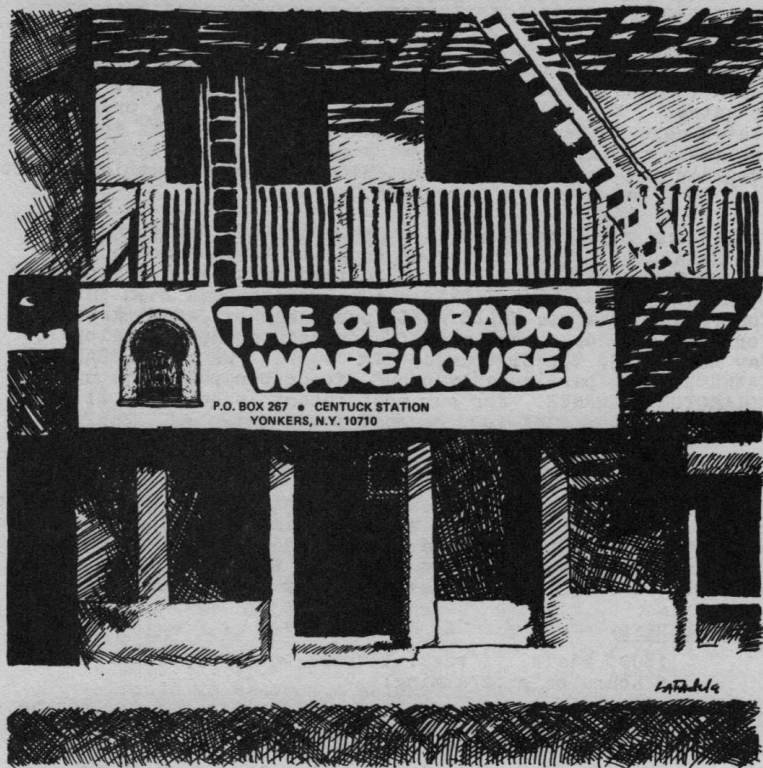

LENDING LIBRARY: An inexpensive way to collect radio shows. All reels listed in our catalog are available for rental. Four reels must be borrowed at a time, and may be held for a period of four weeks. A deposit of \$10.00 is required to join the library. If a reel is lost or damaged, deposit is charged \$2.50. Deposit is returned when library membership is terminated. Cost of borrowing four reels is \$8.00. List the four reels you want most, and list 10 reels as alternate selections.
