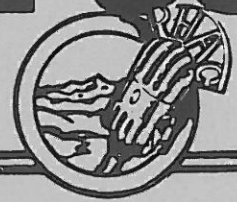

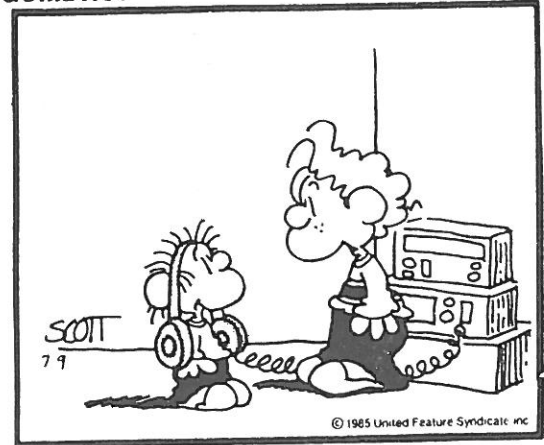

Orson Welles dies at 70; 'boy wonder' left legend

LOS ANGELES — Orson Welles, the Hollywood "boy wonder" who terrified radio listeners with a tale of a Martian invasion and created "Citizen Kane," one of the greatest films of all time, died of a heart attack Thursday at the age of 70.

Detective Russell Kuster said a chauffeur found Welles in an upstairs bedroom of his Hollywood Hills home at about 10 a.m.

"There is no evidence of foul play," Kuster said. "It's obvious the death was of natural causes."

One of the last people to see Welles alive was Patrick Terrail, owner of Ma Maison, a restaurant where the actor ate almost every day and where he had dinner Wednesday night.

"**LAST NIGHT** Orson was in great good health and in fine spirits," Terrail said. "He had just done the Merv Griffin show. He was talking about renegotiating his contract with Paul Masson about doing wine commercials. He also was talking about directing a segment of 'Amazing Stories' for Steven Spielberg."

Actor Burt Reynolds, who said he had lunch Monday with Welles at Ma Maison, told of another project Welles had in mind.

"We met to talk about writing together a segment of the new 'Alfred Hitchcock Presents' (television) series that he would direct and in which I would star," said a shaken Reynolds.

"We were both very excited. He later called me three times to say he couldn't sleep because he was so excited and had so many ideas for the show."

Welles, who reached the pinnacle of his career by the time he was 26, had seen his hopes of making more films rebuffed over the last quarter-century by an industry that praised his genius but gave him only bit parts, talk show slots and commercials.

In fact, many young people knew him mainly for a recent series of wine commercials in which he intoned, "We will sell no wine before its time."

"**IT SEEMS** so many giants have left us," said Janet Leigh, who starred in "A Touch of Evil" with Welles. "I think we lost one of our geniuses. . . ."

"It's no feather in the cap of our Hollywood community that it didn't make better use of his talents," said actor-director John Huston.

Donald Messerle, assistant chief of coroner's investigations, said the death of the portly, 6-foot-3 actor would not be a coroner's case, because Welles had seen his physician within 20 days.

Welles' attorney, Eli Blumenfeld, said

Welles' physician, Dr. Thomas J. Dailey, informed him that the cause of death was a heart attack.

Dailey said Welles had been on a diet and had lost 50 pounds in the last year.

Welles panicked America in 1938 with his Mercury Theater of the Air radio adaptation of H. G. Wells' "War of the Worlds." Despite frequent disclaimers during the broadcast, some listeners believed the nation really was being invaded by Martians.

He stunned the film world in 1941 with his first venture in film, "Citizen Kane," based on the life of publisher William Randolph Hearst. Welles directed, wrote and starred in the film, winning an Oscar for writing. He also was nominated for directing and acting.

IN 1934, he married Virginia Nicholson, and they had a daughter, Christopher. They divorced in 1940. He wed Rita Hayworth in 1943, and they had a daughter, Rebecca. He married Countess di Girafalco after divorcing Hayworth.

"I've set myself against being concerned with any more worldly success than I need to function with," he once said. "Up to a point, I have to be successful in order to operate. But I think it's corrupting to care about success; and nothing could be more vulgar than to worry about posterity."

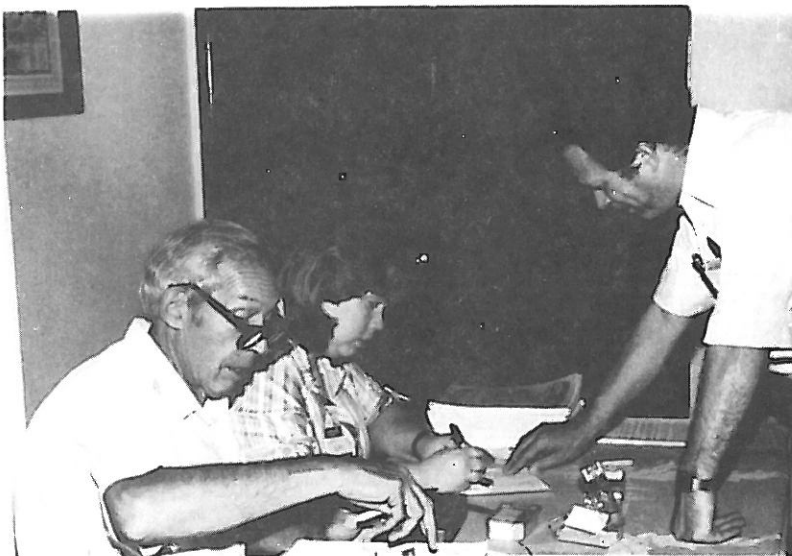
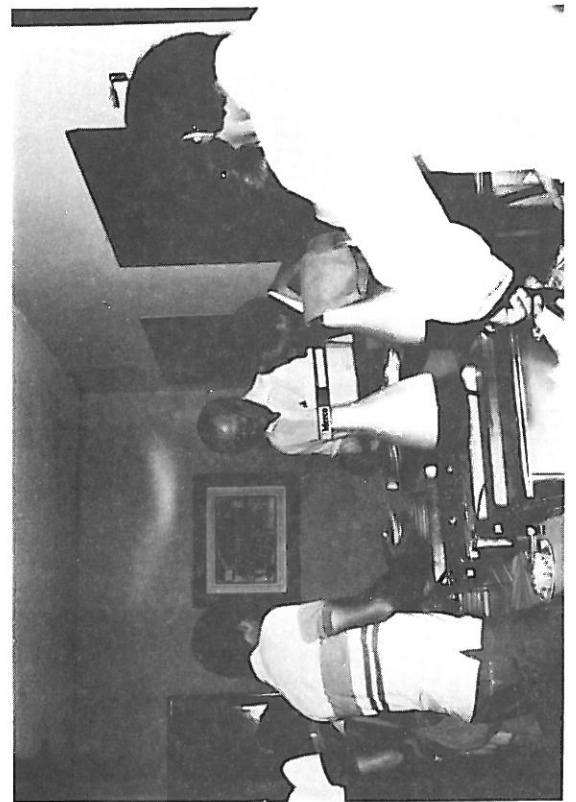
