
### ABOUT THE COVER

# OUT OF MY MIND Dan Decker Editor

Every now and then, one comes across a product or an idea that elicits the response. "Why didn't somebody think of that before!" Well, that was my response when I saw a copy of the recently published book, Radio Dial: Radio Station Guide by Alicia S. O'Drago (AMP Publishing Co.,

456-46 Corona St., Denver CO 80218). This handy soft-cover book which fits handily in the glove compartment lists over 3,500 commercial radio stations in more than 300 cities and towns across the United States, the dial location, call letters, and AM or FM designations. It even provides the listener with each station's hours of operation.

Radio Dial was recently reviewed in Boulder's <u>Daily Camera</u> by David Menconi. the newspaper's music critic in an article entitled "She uses 'Radio Dial,' don't you wish everone did?" The review follows:

On your radio: A while back, Alicia O'Drago of Denver was planning a cross-country driving trip. Her car had an erratic radio that didn't pick up AM stations at all and had limited FM reception, so O'Drago commenced looking for a guidebook of radio stations across the nation. She didn't find one, and decided to write her own to fill the void in the market. The result is "Radio Dial," which O'Drago has published herself with a first printing of 3000 copies.

"Radio Dial" fits neatly in a glove compartment and lists 3500 radio stations in more than 300 cities and towns, broken down by state, city and format. O'Drago spent about three months researching her book, and you'd be amazed at what she turned up out there (an all-comedy station in Lubbock, Texas, for example, or a reggae station in Jackson, Miss.). If the book does well enough, O'Drago is planning on yearly revised editions. For now, "Radio Dial" is available for \$9.95 postage paid. Write AMP Publishing, 456-46 Corona St., Denver 80218.

Two other Denver area papers that reviewed the book were <u>The Denver Post</u> and Westword. The latter had this to say:

White line fever: There's nothing worse than being on a long road trip, eyes propped open with caffeine and the wind in your face, and no music on the radio. You keep punching the dial, hoping a stray station will come in, but all you get are Bible-thumping talk shows and grain reports. When you're home, you know where all the stations are, and what kind of music they offer. But when you're on the road. you'd better have tapes handy. Unless, of course, you have a copy of Alicia O'Drago's new book, Radio Dial.

# JOHN RAYBURN by Vicki Blake

The guest speaker at June's RHAC meeting was the well-known Denver TV-radio personality, John Rayburn. John can currently be heard on KNUS as the host of a talk show and also host of the Senior Showcase on PBS Channel 6. During his 42 year's broadcasting career, he has at one time or another been the evening news host of all three of Denver's major television stations--channels 4, 7, and 9.

John began his career in 1946 when he was just starting college and he took on a part-time job as an announcer. After several months, he began announcing football games. Then he went to Texas and got a job as a d. j. He then began a transition from radio to television while living in Peoria, Illinois. While there, he talked to Charles Corell )of Amos 'n Andy) and Jim Jordan (Fibber). He also was a stand-in announcer for Gene Autry's Melody Ranch. John came to Denver in 1959 to announce a basketball game and has been here ever since. In 1975, he anchored the evening news with Ed Sardella on channel 9, and they held the #1 newsteam honors, which trend has continued with Mike Landis replacing John. John and his wife have traveled the United States and he has written a book about their travels in his book, We the People, a Good News Odyssey.

# **Old-time radio**

INCE WE have become so accustomed to the electronic age of entertainment, it is easy to forget how lovingly we once embraced the medium of radio. It was comforting to have the likes of the Lone Ranger and Green Hornet around and, human nature being what it is, the problems heard on the radio soap operas became our problems.

The old-time radio we knew began with the inception of the National Broadcasting Corp. in 1926, and ceased, for all practical purposes, in 1962 when the networks canceled the last of the dramatic programs. In the years between, we were treated to thousands of hours of the finest entertainment by such greats as Jack Benny, Fred Allen, Fanny Brice and Bob Hope.

Radio historian Ron Lackman may have explained the appeal of old-time radio best. He wrote: "The big wooden radio that held its place of honor in our parlor ... was not something you took to the beach for a little incidental music, something that woke you up in the morning or just reminded you of the time or weather or gave you a little news bulletin. It was nothing to be taken for granted. That old radio was the heart of the house, an important part of our lives."

Our imaginations played a vital part in the enjoyment of radio. We heard and envisioned exactly what we wanted. In effect, old-time radio was as innocent, optimistic and childish as we were—and that is what made it so good.


