

Oh, we certainly did goof last month when we put the wrong page in the newsletter. Pages #223 and 224 are in this month, to complete your catalog.


The map below shows the location of the Friday night reception for our guests at the Village Townhouse clubhouse, begining at 7:00 p.m. on June 8, 1990.

Willard Waterman






