

An investment executive, writer & lecturer, Irving was a member of the Episcopal Church, Denver Press Club, Mensa, R.H.A.C., 10th Mt. Div. of Colo. and the Baker Street Irregulars.

Dwight Weist, best known as narrator for "March of Time" died of a heart attack in late July while in Rhode Island vacationing. He was 81. Once known as "The man of 1,000 voices" for his ability to imitate most age groups and accents, did voices as varied as Adolph Hitler and Franklin Roosevelt. Weist was also "Mr. District Attorney" and acted in "The Shadow", "Buck Rogers in the 25th Century", "Cavalcade of America" and many other radio dramas.


