(APPLAUSE)

CONOVER: Say, Vaughn, you're a baseball fan. Spring training is under way now, and I'm kind of wondering if this year will bring another Gene Bearden!

MONROE: Gene's quite a ball player; "Rookie of the Year" in the American League...pitched two winning games in the Series for Cleveland;
