It stars Andy Griffith -- and a good friend of ours.... the face in the crowd from Hohenwald, Tennessee -- and whatta face ----- Rod Brasfield ! !

T. TEXAS: Mighty glad to BE here, Hank.

SNOW: Boy, it's been too long since you've visited the Opry. Fill us in a little bit....

SNOW: Well, speaking of your records -- how about trottin' one out right now ?

T. TEXAS: AD LIB INTO "BUMMING AROUND"

~~Let's have it!~~

MUSIC: 8:36.34

"BLU' MMING AROUND"....T. TEXAS TYLER

APPLAUSE

SNOW: 8:38.15

~~Mighty fine....T. Texas Tyler...And "T." will be back
In a little while....~~

Say, Rod -- Where's Rod Brasfield ?!!!???

ROD: 8:

(COMING ON) Right here, skipper -- general -- boss---
hoss---!

SNOW: 8:38.20

Aright. Rod -- when I drove past the park today,
was that YOU flying a KITE ? ?!!!

ROD: 8:38.25

Well---don't say it down your nose ! Yes, that
was me ! (HAPPILY) I LOVE to fly a kite. Makes me
think of good Prince Albert Smokin' TobaccO ! !

SNOW:

Come on, Rod....

ROD: 8:38.34

It does ! There's that kite 'wayyyy, 'wayyyy up there.
The breeze is fresh -- like P. A.'s always fresh !
That ole kite glides along smooth and comfortable -- like

SNOW: 8:40.25 About this time every Saturday night, we spend a little time with a song that has a religious note to it...and we sincerely hope you like the one we've picked for tonight.....called....."HIS HANDS" !

MUSIC: 8:40.45 SNOW...."HIS HANDS"

SNOW: 8:42.15 Thank you, folks...thanks very much...Well sir -- what do you say we move over and visit with my good RCA Victor buddy, Chet Atkins ? Here's Chet pickin' out some mighty fine stuff under the heading of "GAY RANCHERO " !

APPLAUSE

MUSIC: 8:42.23 "GAY RANCHERO...CHET ATKINS...."

APPLAUSE

SNOW: 8:44.01 Mighty fine, Chet...thank you. Well sir, if you don't believe as we do that good things come in small packages, well -- you've got another "think" comin'. Take a look right here -- 'cause here's our proof -- little JUNE CARTER !!

SNOW: 8:47.50 ~~Enjoyed talkin' to you a whole lot, June. Thank you.~~

GRANT: 8:47.56 I think we oughta stop the show and all go fishin'.
~~I'm all clutched up!~~

SNOW: Grant... ~~will you settle down~~ ? How come you wanna fish ?

GRANT: It's a fine way to relax. Course, the BEST way is to go fishin' AND bring along that fine Prince Albert Smokin' Tobacco and the O. C. B. papers. SNOW: AD LIB INTO CLOSING SONG...

MUSIC ^{8:54.20} "A FADED PETAL FROM A BEAUTIFUL BOUQUET"... SNOW

APPLAUSE

MUSIC: "LEATHER BRITCHES"... FIDDLE... FADE ON CUE FOR...

SNOW: ^{8:57.25} We sure had a fine time visitin' with you tonight and we hope you enjoyed yourselves at the Grand Ole Opry. Next week, be on hand 'cause we'll come callin' for you in the old buckboard and up in the drivers seat will be my good friend and yours....the ole TEXAS TROUBADOR, ERNEST TUBB..... and he's bringing along Hank Locklin as his special guest. Till then, this is Hank Snow saying thanks for everything and we'll be seeing you next Saturday night at the Grand Ole Opry !
