LOCKLIN: Sure does. A salute to the greatest country music there is.

TUBB: 9,38 And that means a salute to fine Prince Albert Smoking Tobacco, too -- because P. A. and the Grand Ole Opry go hand in hand.

(APPLAUSE)

TUBB: Thank you, folks....thanks a lot. Got a good friend of yours: standin' over there, just rarin' to pick for you. So what do you say we all ease on over to enjoy a song called 'Cruising Down The River''--played extra special by Chet Atkins!

(APPLAUSE)

MUSIC: "CRUISING DOWN THE RIVER".... CHET ATKINS (TUBB OVER)

TUBB: Mighty good, C het...thank you. Well, we always get a big kick out of it when one of our Grand Ole Opry stars does something kinda special. On May 23th, there's a new Elia Kazan motion picture going to premiere in Hollywood... a picture called "A Face In The Crowd", starring Andy Griffith. And by cracky, one of those faces belongs to

our own Rod --- "Beanie" -- Brasfield !
