ROD: 8 Can you help me finish this poem ? What sounds the best ?  
 " Prince Albert packs a pip of a pipe !"....or....."A pip of a pipe packed with P. A. "? (HAWK OVER)

HAWK: <sup>8:39.46</sup> ~~Next time you say that, point yourself the other way....~~

ROD: (CHUCKLING) ~~Okay .....~~

HAWK: <sup>8:39.50</sup> Rod, I like it both ways.... Means the same thing... means every time you pack ypur pipe with good P. A., you're puffin' your way to real comfort. That's 'cause P. A.'s always fresh... always cool smokin' ... It's crimp cut to burn smooth and even.... and it's always so tasty...
