SNOW: 8:36.20 Hey -- will you fellas settle down long enough to do a song?

OSCAR: We'd be pleased to. (AD LIB INTO SONG)

MUSIC: 8:36.40 " Golden Star "..... LONZO AND OSCAR

(APPLAUSE)

ROD: 8:39.20 Hey, Mister Snow -- by ned, do you know this is the time a
lot of college fellas start buying back-to-school things?

SNOW: 8:39.30 So?

(ROD OVER)

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ROD: So I wanna tell all you pipe-smoking fellas to be sure to pack their new pipes with fine Prince Albert Smoking Tobacco !

SNOW: Hey -- good Idea, Rod. Know why? Because P.A. Is the best doggone thing that ever happened to a fella and his pipe.

ROD: P.A.'s crimp cut --

Well sir, we have a Grand Ole Opry star who is not a fisherman and I'd put his tall stories up against anybody's !! Let's say hello to Hohenwald, Tennessee's first citizen -- Rod Brasfield !!

GRANT: 8:50.12 I guess so. I was just thinkin' how everything changes -- the seasons -- pretty soon -- no more summer...the leaves will change...

SNOW: Enjoyed that, Del, thank you. We'd like to do a song we recorded recently...one we sincerely hope you're gonna like a whole lot. Here's "I Don't Hurt Anymore".

MUSIC: FIDDLE..." Soldiers' Joy"...FADE ON CUE FOR:
