HUSKEY: Yessir--and to add a little more pickin and singin to that -- our special guests are the Tennessee Mountain Boys -- Johnny and Jack !!

HUSKEY: There's just nobody like The Jordanaires ! And--there's nobody like our guests tonight. Two of the biggest stars in the field of country music -- let's welcome Johnny and Jack !!!

HUSKEY: Fellas--you're always welcome at the Grand Ole Opry.

J&J: Thank you, Ferllin.

HUSKEY: Y'know, we hear you gents are travellin' all around these days. How about tellin the folks where you'll be in the days ahead?

J & J : (AD LIB PERSONAL APPEARANCE, PLACES AND DATES

HUSKEY: FINE. Now--before you take off -- how about takin' off on one of your new record releases -- maybe "~~Love Fever?~~"

JACK: Coming right up, Ferllin !

HUSKEY: ~~Really enjoyed that, Rod.~~ Now if you'll gimme the password Jack, I think maybe we'll let you sing.

JACK: The password? Well, how's -- "PACK YOUR PIPE WITH P.A.?"
