broadcast of your Grand Ole Opry... tonight, starring the
Texas Troubador... Ernest Tubb!

(APPLAUSE & CHEERS..... HOLD TILL ERNEST SINGS:)

MUSIC: "Mississippi Gal"..... ERNEST TUBB

(APPLAUSE)

TUBB: Thank you, folks... and a mighty warm welcome to the
Grand Ole Opry. We're real glad to have you... and I'm
speaking for....

GRANT: --Rod Brasfield !

TUBB: Chet Atkins

GRANT: --The Old Hickory Singers!

TUBB: --Stringbean !

GRANT: --The Opry Square Dancers!

TUBB: --And the entire Opry gang ! And by cracky, if that's
not enough---we'll turn loose our special guest star---
George Jones !

(APPLAUSE)

(TUBB OVER)

PRINCE ALBERT OPRY # 2

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TUBB: Yessir, it's another big night at the Grand Ole Opry---and we're gonna keep it rollin' along with four old timers who have been putting their heads together for a mellow song for lots of Saturday nights. Let's have a real welcome for... The Old Hickory Singers doin' "I Want a Girl" !
"I WANT A GIRL" !!!

(APPLAUSE)

MUSIC: "I WANT A GIRL"... OLD HICKORY SINGERS

(APPLAUSE)

TUBB: Yessir ! The Old Hickory Singers... sure enjoyed that, fellas. And you know---here's somebody else we always enjoy. He's one of the young, new stars at the Opry and you seem to really like his get-up-and-go country songs, so let's roll out the welcome mat for George Jones !

(APPLAUSE)

TUBB: George---make yourself right to home.

JONES: Thanks, Ernest. And thanks for askin' me over.

TUBB: Glad to have you... especially with you so busy playing for the folks on your busy road schedule. What's coming up for you in the weeks ahead, George?

JONES: (AD LIB RE: PERSONAL APPEARANCES... PLACES & DATES)

TUBB: Well, while you're standing still tonight... how about sing'ng us a song?

(JONES OVER)

PRINCE ALBERT OPRY #3

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JONES: Glad to, Ernest. Here's "TALL, TALL TREES" !!!
(APPLAUSE)

MUSIC: "TALL, TALL TREES ... GEORGE JONES
(APPLAUSE)

ROD: Mister Tubb...don't you just love this time of year??
Football !! Y'know, last night I went to a "pipe" rally !

TUBB: Rod...you mean a "pep" rally...

ROD: I know what I saw ! It was a pipe rally ! Never seen so
many fellas packin' their pipes with good Prince Albert
Smoking Tobacco. By ned, I think I'll just rare back and
give a yell for P. A. !

TUBB: Rod, take it easy ! You don't have to "yell" about Prince

MUSIC: "THE OLD RUGGED CROSS"....ERNEST TUBB
(APPLAUSE)

TUBB: Thank you, folks, thanks a whole lot. You know somethin'? We haven't had a whole bushel basket of guitar pickin' tonight... so what do you say we call on Chet Atkins and ask him to do one of his RCA Victor tunes for us... something like "GOODY, GOODY"? Chet Atkins !!
(APPLAUSE)

(MUSIC OVER)

PRINCE ALBERT #5

MUSIC: "GOODY, GOODY".....CHET ATKINS
(APPLAUSE)

TUBB: Mighty fine, Chet, thank you. Well sir---I'm sure all of you have seen at least a movie of a jet plane taking off. Well, that's just about the way our Grand Ole Opry is gonna take off right now. We're leaving the world of sanity and headin' for another planet and the land of tall, tall stories. Here's our own space cadet--Rod Brasfield !
(APPLAUSE & PLAYON)

(ROD)

(APPLAUSE & PLAYOFF)

ROD: Hey, Mister Tubb---stop everything ! Do you know that next week is the start of national "Rock and Roll" week ~~???~~?

TUBB: So??

ROD: So I wanna tell all our friends who are makin' men to rock right down to the corner store, get some Prince Albert Smoking Tobacco and some O.C.B. papers, and roll yourself some of the best-tastin', best-lookin' cigarettes you ever enjoyed !

MUSIC: "CRIPPLE CREEK"..... STRINGBEAN
(APPLAUSE)
(GUITAR STRUM IN BG)

TUBB: Before any more time gets away from us here at the Opry, the Tourbadors and I would like to do one of our songs. Hope you like "MY TREASURE".

MUSIC: "MY TREASURE"..... ERNEST TUBB
(APPLAUSE)

MUSIC: START FIDDLE... "RAG TIME ANNIE".... FADE FOR:

TUBB: We always have a good time doin' the Opry for you and we sure hope all you folks here at the Ryman and listening in enjoyed your visit with us. Come on back next week when we'll come callin for you in the ole buckboard and when your star will be Peter Wagoner along with Dave Rich, as his guest. Till then, this is Ernest Tubb sayin thanks for everything... be better to your neighbors and you'll have better neighbors... and we'll be seeing you next Saturday night at the Grand Ole Opry !!
