GRANT: Yes...and Del Wood....Tommy Jackson and the Opry Square Dancers...

HANK: AND...our special guests...Wilma Lee And Stony Cooper !!

HANK: Now, here's the Ole Hickory Singers...with a grand old timer... "By The Beautiful Sea."
