off with the list of tonight's entertainers.

GRANT:

Right you are, Faron. First off...we've got Miss June Carter with us...arong with the Jordanaires...

FARON:

Our guitar playin' friend, Chet Atkins...

GRANT:

... Stringbean... Tommy Jackson... the Opry Square Dancers...

FARON:

...AND....Our special guest....CARL BUTLER!!

(A PPLAUSE)

(FARON OVER)

FARON:

Now get set for a real musical treat... as we listen to a fine number by those four boys who sing a great song... THE JORDANAIRES!!

(APPLAUSE)

FARON:

that's a great number and you do it better than anybody I know.

Well now...we've got a big tall handsome guest on the show
tonight that I know all you ladies out there are just dyin' to
see...so let's get him out here with a great big round of
applause....CARL BUTLER!

(APPLAUSE)

FARON:

Cari...welcome to the Grand Ole Opry!

CARL:

Thanks, Faron... I sure am glad to be here. And thanks for that nice introduction. Of course... you know it's not true.

FARON:

What do you mean, "Not true?"

CAR:

Wen..didn't you say I was big..an' tan...and handsome?

FARON:

Yeah... yeah... I believe it went something like that.

Well now you know I ain't so tall.

(A PPLAUSE)

CARL

(HUMS, AS HE HURRIES PAST) Oh do-da- do da dum-dum-dum...

FARON:

(STOPS HIM) Hold it, fella....what's the hurry?

CARL:

Why, shucks, Faron....the world series starts next week...an'll got to be ready!!

FARON:

Ready for what?

Well...th' way I look at it.... next week there's gonna be some mighty tense moments an' toto of folks will need plenty of calm comfort.

.... the old songs we learned at the little country churches that played such a big part in our lives. And as we remember we like to lift up our voices in those old hymns. and sing His praise... and think just a little about the life that is to come. later on.

MUS IC:

"MANS ION OVER THE HILL"... FARON YOUNG

(APPLAUSE)

FARON:

Thank you,...thanks so much...you're all wonderful people.

Isn't that right, Grant Turner?

GRANT:

They're the greatest ever, Faron. Now...what are you aimin' to

do to entertain 'em ?

(FARON OVER)

FARON:

Me: I'm not aimin' to do anything, Grant...but we have got a featured performer who can. I'm talkin' about that boy who really plays the fire out of a guitar...CHESTER ATKINS!!

(APPLAUSE)

FARON:

And here he is...with..."Swing Low...Sweet Chariot." Chester...

let's go!!

MUSIC:

"SWING LOW SWEET CHARIOT"... CHESTER ATKINS

(A PPLAUSE)

FARON:

Chet Atkins. the king of the guitar players. Thanks so much, Chester. But now... sort of goin' from the sublime. to the rediculous... it's time we met the gal who calls her new car... "Rabbit".. because it always heads for the woods... "MISS JUNE CARTER!!!

APPLAUSE & PLAY ON"

APPLAUSE & PLAY OFF

GRANT:

Well, Faron, now that the fall season's on us, I guess you'll be hittin' the mead to make those personal appearances again.

Doesn't that travelin' get you down? Don't you miss all the comforts of home?

FARON:

I sure do, Grant, but let me tell you somethin'. Out on the road, I get a lot of COMFORT out of my pipe.....loaded with that good Prince Albert Smokin' Tobacco.

(APPLAUSE)

MUSIC:

"I WONDER WHERE WANDA WENT"... STRING

(A PPLAUSE)

FARON:

Stringbean...with a little tune called..." I Wonder Where Wanda Went." Thanks a lot. String.

(GRANT OVER)

GRANT:

Faron... I hate to interrupt...

FARON:

That's all right, Grant..that's all right.

GRANT:

Time's gettin' a little close...and I want to talk to you just a minute before you go into your last number. You've been out on the road quite a bit lately... I wonder if you'd care to tell us about it?

FARON:

AD LIBS BRIEFLY ABOUT PERSONALS

GRANT:

Well great, Faron. And I happen to know you've got a couple of new records out on the Capitol label. The first one you did tonight was one...and now it's time you let the folks hear the other one. Here he is, neighbors...Faron Young..with his latest record..." Hate Myself."

(APPLAUSE)

MUSIC:

"I HATE MYSELF"...FARON YOUNG

(APPLAUSE)

MUSIC:

"OLD JOE CLARK"...T. JACKSON. FADE UNDER AS BG FOR:

(FA RON OVER)

FARON:

That's the story for tonight, neighbors. It was sure nice havin'you with us here at the Grand Ole Opry, Join us next week when _______ will be your star and he'll have ______ along as his guest. Till then...this is Faron Young sayin' "Thanks" ... and we'll be seein' you NEXT week at the GRAND...OLE....OPRY!!
