(APPLAUSE)

MUSIC: "LAST NIGHT AT A PARTY".....FARON YOUNG

(APPLAUSE)

FARON: Thank you...thanks just a whole lot...and WELCOME...to The Grand Ole Opry. I know you're gonna have a good time because we got a great show all lined up for you. And here to tell you about some of the entertainers is my good friend.....GRANT TURNER !!

GRANT: Big show is what we got, Faron ! First of all...Miss June Carter is with us...and our good friend Archie Campbell ,

FARON: Yes...and Chester Atkins...Miss Del Wood ....

GRANT: ...Tommy Jackson ...Ralph Sloan and The Tennessee Travelers.....

(FARON OVER)

FARON: ...and last but by no means least,...our very special guests...  
that singin',... laughin' group of entertainers who have become  
great favorites with the Opry audience,...THE CARLISLES !!

(APPLAUSE)

FARON: We'll be hearin' from The Carlises in just a few minutes...  
but right now it's time we turned to the more sober things  
in life....at least I HOPE he is!...ARCHIE CAMPBELL !!

(APPLAUSE & PLAYON)

ARCHIE'S ROUTINE

(APPLAUSE & PLAYOFF)

FARON: Thank you,...Archie Campbell. And now it's "guest time"  
on The Opry and I want to tell you that we just couldn't have  
nicer guests than we got this evening. So let's make 'em  
real welcome and let 'em know how much we appreciate their  
bein' here....let's hear it for.....THE CARLISLES !!

(APPLAUSE)

FARON: Welcome to the Opry, Bill. Let me shake your hand.  
Folks,...in case you don't know....this is Bill Carlisle....  
the leader and sort of boss-man of the bunch. Welcome to  
the Opry, Bill !!

(BILL CARLISLE OVER)

BILL: Just so pleased and happy to be here, Faron. Just about as pleased as a speckled pup under the dinin' room table.

FARON: And this....oh man....I ain't gonna shake hands with this one... 'cause this is pretty little Dottie Sills. Dottie, how come a good-lookin' gal like you got mixed up with these other two ?

DOTTIE: You mean Bill an' Honey Bear, Faron ? Oh, they're nice.

FARON: And this young man over here....this is Honey Bear...an' come to think of it...he looks a little like one...what with the beard an' all. But...we aren't here to talk ...we're here to play music....so William....what is your first number gonna' be?

BILL: Faron....it's a little thing (AD LIBS BRIEFLY ABOUT IT) and it goes like this !!

(APPLAUSE)

MUSIC: "I DON'T WANT TO RUN".....CARLISLES

(APPLAUSE)

(ANNCR OVER)

ANNCR: Faron, you sure have been travelin' since the first of the year.  
You must like singin' :

FARON: (Almost as much as I like Prince Albert Smokin' Tobacco.  
Someday, I'm gonna write a song about P.A.

ANNCR: There've been several. But just what would YOU sing about?

FARON: Ohhh, I don't know. The fact that P.A.'s always fresh,  
maybe...or that it's crimp cut.

ANNCR: You COULD sing about the downright satisfyin' FLAVOR of  
Prince Albert. How the flavor of the fine tobacco is locked  
IN by the special P.A. process.

FARON: Yeah... I could. But the theme of a song should be about  
somethin' HAPPY ! a 7 0 16

ANNCR: Well, I think how HAPPY Prince Albert can make any pipe  
smoker. As a matter of fact...with Prince Albert, a man gets  
such a tasty, satisfyin' ...COMFORTABLE...smoke he just has  
to be happy. (The same goes for makin' men because P.A.

MUSIC: "OLD JOE CLARK".....T.JACKSON...FADE UNDER AS BG FOR :

(FARON OVER)

FARON: Now, for the square dancin',...here's Tommy Jackson...  
Ralph Sloan and the Tennessee Travelers,..all set to cut a  
few capers to the tune of "OLD JOE CLARK."

MUSIC: " OLD JOE CLARK".....TOMMY JACKSON & DANCERS

(APPLAUSE)

FARON: Tommy Jackson and all the Square Dancers....cuttin' the  
buck mighty high and fancy. Thank you, Tommy and thank  
you , Dancers !!

GRANT: Faron...that was really somethin'...but now that the  
dancin' is over...it's time we got on to the next part of our  
show.

FARON: Which is...what, Grant ?

GRANT: Why...that portion we like to call...,"hymn time"...and I  
know all the good folks are anxious and waitin' to hear what  
you have to offer.

MUSIC CUE....SNEAK IN UNDERSCORE...AS FARON GOES RIGHT ON

FARON: Grant...it's a part of the show that I like too...and this  
evenin' we've selected a number with a real message in it for  
us all. A little thing called...,"When I've Learned"...and it  
goes like this:

(MUSIC OVER.....FARON)

MUSIC: 'WHEN I'VE LEARNED'.....FARON YOUNG

(APPLAUSE)

FARON: Thank you,....thank you so much,....you're a wonderful audience. But now, it's time we went on to another portion of our show that happens to be a favorite of mine. It's that time when our good friend Chet Atkins takes his guitar in his lap and plays a tune like nobody else in the whole wide world. Here he is,....and tonight it's,...."JOHNSON RAG" !!

(APPLAUSE)

MUSIC: "JOHNSON RAG".....CHET ATKINS

APPLAUSE

FARON: Thank you, Chester Atkins !! I sure wish I could play like that. And speakin' of playin'...it's time we heard from our PLAY-GIRL of the Ozarks....so here she is....and let's make her welcome,....MISS ....JUNE....CARTER !!

(APPLAUSE & PLAYON)

JUNE'S ROUTINE

(APPLAUSE & PLAYOFF)

( COMMERCIAL OVER )

FARON: June, you look all flustered and upset. How come?

JUNE: I just give my boyfriend his Valentine an' he was so tickled he up and' hugged me an' kissed me <sup>me</sup> like anything.

FARON: ~~By Golly... this is~~ Valentine Day. Was it all done up in red paper, with a white ribbon, June ?

JUNE: No...it was done up in red tin...with a blue stamp across the top.

FARON: Oh sure....you are talkin' about Prince Albert Smokin' Tobacco. No wonder your boyfriend was pleased. Any smokin' man would be tickled pink to get a gift like that. (APPLAUSE)

FARON: The Carlisles...and "Uncle Bud". Thank you, Bill...and our thanks to Dottie and Honey Bear....for bein' our guests. It was great havin' you here. Well now....it's time we heard from another of our great Opry regulars...so here she is at the piano...Miss Del Wood....playin'... "Sunday...Down South."

(APPLAUSE)

MUSIC: "SUNDAY DOWN SOUTH".....DEL WOOD

(APPLAUSE)

FARON: Miss Del Wood and "Sunday Down South"....That was really great, Del.

GRANT : It certainly was, Faron...but since our time is gettin' a little close....maybe you'd better tell us a little about yourself... where you been...where you're goin'...and what you been up to.

( FARON OVER )



FARON: Well, Grant,...like an old fellow in show business used to say when he was asked those same questions...."I been over there....an' I'm goin' over yonder....and as to what I've been up to....I can tell you this....it ain't been to any good !"  
But all jokin' aside.....AD LIBS BRIEFLY ABOUT COMING TOUR

GRANT: Well, that's a pretty fair account. Now then....how about letting the audience hear one of those big records of yours. Here he is, folks.....Faron Young with his Capitol Record of...

FARON: Well, neighbors....that does the business for us tonight...but I just want to say that it was sure great havin' you here with us at The Grand Ole Opry. Next week Ferlin' Husky will be leadin' the band and Homer and Jethro will be along as his guest. Listen then, won't you. Now...this is Faron Young, sayin'...."Thanks"...and we'll be seein' you NEXT week at...  
The Grand Ole Opry !!
