It comes from one of our regular listeners over at Dupont, Georgia who wrote in and asked for it. So for him... and for all our listeners everywhere... here's Ernest Tubb... singing "Stand By Me."

MUSIC: "STAND BY ME".....ERNEST TUBB

(APPLAUSE)

TUBB: Thank you... thank you so much. And thanks to Mr. Calburn for requestin' it. But now it's time we heard from a boy who gets hundreds of requests... every week. He's one of the finest gentlemen I know... and a great guitar player. Chester Atkins... and ... "Black Mountain Rag."

(APPLAUSE)

MUSIC: "BLACK MOUNTAIN RAG".....CHET ATKINS

Chet Atkins and "Black Mountain Rag." Thank you, Chester.

good friend of Chester's... and one of our most popular

TUBB: Thank you, Grandpa..., thanks just a whole lot. It's always a pleasure to have you with us.

GRANT: It certainly is a pleasure, Ernest..., and it's always a pleasure to have you sing one of your great songs for us, too.

TUBB: Thank you, Grant.

GRANT: Before you start on the song..., I know all the folks would like to hear about your big trip.

TUBB: AD LIBS BRIEFLY ABOUT PAST TRIP... FUTURE DATES... ETC...

TUBB: Sounds like a real strenuous trip, Ernest. But now it's time for ~~a~~ song..., so how about that big Decca hit of yours., "What Am I Living For."

TUBB: Be glad to sing it, Grant !!
