MUSIC: "KISSING YOUR PICTURE".....RAY PRICE

(APPLAUSE)

GRANT: Ray Price and his big hit, "Kissing Your Picture." Thank you, Ray....and welcome to The Grand Ole Opry !!

RAY: Good to be here, Grant...and I want to extend a very special welcome to all the good folks out there who've joined us for tonight's show !!

GRANT: And we have got a great show lined up, Ray...a really great show .

RAY: Maybe you better tell 'em about it, Grant !!

GRANT: First off....we've got Miss June Carter with us.

RAY: And Archie Campbell and my good friend, Chester Atkins !!

GRANT: Stringbean...Tommy Jackson...Ralph Sloan and The Tennessee Travelers...All the Clorokee Cowboys...

(PRICE OVER)

RAY: And as our very special guest...The Queen of Country Music,
KITTY WELLS !!

(APPLAUSE)

RAY: We'll have one of Kitty's great songs in just a few minutes
...but right now it's time we heard from that expert on women,
who says...,"A wife may not select her husband's suits...
but she usually picks his pockets"...the sage of Bulls Gap ,
Tennessee.....ARCHIE CAMPBELL !!

(APPLAUSE & PLAYON)

ARCHIE'S ROUTINE

(APPLAUSE & PLAYOFF)

RAY: Archie Campbell...the sage of Bulls Gap. Thank you, Archie.
Thanks a lot. Which brings us down to "guest time" on
this evening's show....and when I say we have a guest.... I
mean she is just about the best guest we could have. Let's
have a great big hand for the Queen of Country Music..
MISS KITTY WELLS !!

(APPLAUSE)

RAY: Kitty...I just want to tell you how pleased and proud we are
to have you here with us tonight !

KITTY: Thank you, Ray.

(RAY OVER)

RAY: I know everybody's eager and anxious to hear you sing...so how about that big number you've just brought out?

KITTY: Be glad to, Ray. It's one of our latest Decca records.. "Mommy For A Day."

(APPLAUSE)

MUSIC: "MOMMY FOR A DAY".....KITTY WELLS

(APPLAUSE)

RAY: Grant...I just remembered somethin'. ^{you know} Next Wednesday is April Fool's Day and I reckon the kids are gettin set for some great tricks.

GRANT: ~~Yes~~...we're gonna have to be mighty careful about what we open. Candy boxes will have spring snakes in 'em and all that sort of thing. But there is somethin' ^{that} we don't have to worry about when we open it.

RAY: What's that, Grant?

GRANT: ^{oh}A can of good Prince Albert Smokin' Tobacco !

RAY: I'll say it was, Grant !!

(GRANT OVER)

GRANT: But now we have to get on with the rest of the show, Ray...
and I reckon you know who's elected and what you have to do?

RAY: "Hymn Time", Grant...and you know somethin? I
personally like this part of the show best !!

MUSIC:CUE: SNEAK IN UNDERSCORE AS RAY CONTINUES :

RAY: The hymn we want to do is one that tells of the power and
the glory of the Lord...and how He's always ready to help us...
if only we'll ask. "Call The Lord And He'll Be There."

MUSIC: "CALL THE LORD AND HE'LL BE THERE".....RAY PRICE
(APPLAUSE)

RAY: Thank you....thanks so much .

GRANT: Ray....that was great !

RAY: Thank you, Grant. And now it's time we called on one of our
featured performers here on the Grand Ole Opry. He plays
just about the best guitar in the world...his name is
Chester Atkins ...and his tune is...."HELLO BLUEBIRD."

(APPLAUSE)

MUSIC: "HELLO BLUEBIRD".....CHET ATKINS

(APPLAUSE)

(PRICE OVER)

RAY: Chester Atkins and "Hello Bluebird." Thank you , Chester., thanks so much. Which brings us down to another high spot in the Grand Ole Opry and one EVERYBODY is waitin' for... the appearance of that girl who believes in love at first sight because it saves so much time.....**MISS JUNE CARTER!!**

(APPLAUSE & PLAYON)

JUNE'S ROUTINE

(APPLAUSE & PLAYOFF)

RAY: June... how are you comin' on your campaign to get your boyfriend to marry you?

JUNE: Ohhhhh... I'm just workin' so hard. *ya know* I invite him over to eat... and when he gets there, I try to make him ~~as~~ comfortable as I know how.

RAY: *well* June... *meal* it'll work... because there's nothin' a man likes better than his comfort. That's why so many pipe smokers rely on Prince Albert. regular Grand Ole Opry featured performers. I'm talkin'
about the old Kentucky Wonder himself.....STRINGBEAN...
playin' and singin'...."I Wonder Where Wanda Went."

(APPLAUSE)

MUSIC: "I WONDER WHERE WANDA WENT".....STRINGBEAN

(APPLAUSE)

RAY: Thank you, String...thanks a whole lot !!

(GRANT OVER)

GRANT: Ray,...before you start into your last big number, I wonder if you'd mind tellin' us a little about where you've been and where you're headin' for in your next tour?

RAY: Be glad to, Grant...(AD LIBS BRIEFLY ABOUT TOUR)

GRANT: We all wish you the best of luck. Now...it's time for a song...so here he is, neighbors....Ray Price, the Cherokee Cowboy, with his big Columbia record...,"That's What It's Like To Be Lonely,"

(APPLAUSE)

MUSIC: "THAT'S WHAT IT'S LIKE TO BE LONELY"....RAY PRICE

(APPLAUSE)

MUSIC: T. JACKSON... "SUGAR IN THE GOURD"... FADE UNDER AS BG FOR:

RAY: Well, neighbors...that's about it for this evening. It was sure nice havin' you here with us at The Grand Ole Opry. Listen NEXT week when _____ will be headin' up the show and will have my good friend, Bill Anderson, along as guest. Till then...this is Ray Price, sayin'... 'Thanks'...and we'll be lookin' for you NEXT week...at the GRAND...OLE... OPRY !!
