HAWK: Good to be here, Grant !

GRANT: You got a great show lined up for the folks this evening, Hawk...a GREAT show !!

HAWK: Well, tell 'em about it, Grant.....tell 'em about it !

GRANT: I'm just fixin' to, First off, neighbors...we've got that funny man , Archie Campbell, with us. Then there's the Jordanaires...

HAWK: ...Don't forget my good buddy, Chester Atkins...

GRANT: ...Stringbean...Tommy Jackson...Ben Smathers and the Stoney Mountain Cloggers...

(HAWK OVER)

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HAWK: ...and as our special guest,, Lovely Miss Jean Shepard !!

(APPLAUSE)

HAWK: We'll hear from Jean in just a few minutes. Right now it's time for our great quartet , so here they are,, The Jordanaires, with,, "One Of These Mornings."

(APPLAUSE)

MUSIC: "ONE OF THESE MORNINGS".....JORDANAIRES

(APPLAUSE)

HAWK: The Jordanaires and "One Of These Mornings" , Thank you Jordanaires,,, thanks a lot, Which brings us down to the spot when we usually introduce our guest,, and seein' how we've got one of the prettiest little guests in the world with us,, let's bring her out here and make her feel right at home,, MISS JEAN SHEPARD !!

(APPLAUSE)

HAWK: Jean,,, welcome to the Grand Ole Opry !

JEAN: Thank you, Hawk,, it's nice to be back here,

HAWK: You can sure say that again, Jean, I'm glad to be back myself,

GRANT: That's right, Hawk. You and Jean have both been away on tour. Out West, as I remember !

( JEAN OVER)

JEAN: That's right, Grant ! We covered about ten thousand miles this time,

GRANT: Imagine that! You're both gonna be in for a while now, I take it?

HAWK: I sure hope so ! But let's not stand here and talk about our trip. Let's get a little music goin', Jean... I know you've got a brand new record out on the Capitol label. How about givin' the folks a sample ! Here she is, neighbors... Miss Jean Shepard with her new record... "I'll Take The Blame For It All."

MUSIC: "I'LL TAKE THE BLAME FOR IT ALL".....JEAN SHEPARD

(APPLAUSE)

HAWK: Grant Turner... you're a solid pipe smoker. Tell me, just what it is that you like <sup>best</sup> about Prince Albert !

(GRANT OVER)

HAWK: Back in the days when I was a little kid goin' to church and Sunday School, there was a song we used to sing that always used to mean a lot to me. With your permission...and the help of the Jordanaires...I'd like to sing it for you...right now. "Amazing Grace."

MUSIC: "AMAZING GRACE".....HAWK & JORDANAIRES

(APPLAUSE)

HAWK: Thank you...thanks a lot. You're a great audience and I think all the world of every one of you. Now...back from a great tour in the eastern part of the United States is our good friend, Chet Atkins. So here he is...along with his guitar...to play..." \_\_\_\_\_."

(APPLAUSE)

(MUSIC OVER...CHET)

MUSIC: " .....CHET ATKINS

(APPLAUSE)

HAWK: Chester Atkins...playin'........." Thanks Chet. Thanks A lot. Which brings us down to the educational spot on our show. The spot where we introduce that man whose wife threw his best suit out of the second story window last night. He wouldn't have minded so much...except that HE WAS IN IT. That Bull's Gap Hotshot...ARCHIE CAMPBELL !!

(APPLAUSE & PLAYON)

ARCHIE'S ROUTINE

(APPLAUSE & PLAYOFF)

HAWK: Archie, <sup>slight joke</sup> is it true your friend the sword swallower is on a diet? <sup>don't you run off wood</sup>

ARCHIE: <sup>ain't</sup> Hasn't had a thing but straight pins for a week now, Hawk. But he don't mind. Not so long as they let him have all the Prince Albert Smokin' Tobacco he wants.

GRANT: Who else, Hawk?

HAWK: Well, good deal. Here he is, neighbors..... Stringbean...and "Short Life and Trouble." Whip it, String...whip it !!

MUSIC: "SHORT LIFE AND TROUBLE".....STRINGBEAN

HAWK: 'Short Life and Trouble'....it could be my own story. Thanks String...thanks a lot.

GRANT: Now, Hawk...it's your time on the show. I know you've got a new record out. Would you like to tell the folks just a little bit about it?
