GRANT: Ernest Tubb...with the help of The Jordanaires...and "Hey, Mister Bluebird".....and a great song it is. Thank you, Ernest.. and welcome...to The Grand Ole Opry.

ERNEST: Thank you, Grant...it's a pleasure to be here. But seein' how we got a great show lined up tonight...don't you think you better tell the folks about it?

GRANT: Just fixin' to, Ernest...just fixin' to do that very thing. Neighbors...besides Ernest and all The Texas Troubadors we've got Archie Campbell with us...The Jordanaires...

ERNEST: ....my good friend Chester Atkins. Miss Del Wood....

GRANT: ....Tommy Jackson...Ralph Sloan and The Tennessee Travelers...

ERNEST: And as our very special guest...that young star who's just joined The Grand Ole Opry...**BILLY GRAMMER!**  
(GRANT OVER)

APPLAUSE

ERNEST: We'll be havin' a song from Billy in just a few minutes. Right now it's time we heard one of those great numbers from our spiritual singin' quartet..The Jordanaires...with..."In That Great Gettin' Up Morning".

APPLAUSE

MUSIC: "IN THAT GREAT GETTIN' UP MORNING".....JORDANAIRE

APPLAUSE

ERNEST: The Jordanaires with "In That Great Gettin' Up Morning".., one of the feature numbers from the boys new Capitol Album... "Glory Land". Thank you, Jordanaires...thanks a lot. And now it's time we brought our guest out here...so let's give him a great big Opry welcome.....BILLY GRAMMER!!

APPLAUSE

ERNEST: Billy...welcome to the Grand Ole Opry. It's a pleasure to have you with us.

BILLY: It's a pleasure to be here, Ernest.

ERNEST: You've been a right busy entertainer in the past few weeks, William.

(BILLY OVER)

BILLY: Yes...and it looks like I'm gonna be even busier in the days to come.

ERNEST: I heard about your trip. Louisville...New Orleans...Laurel... Hattiesburg...two days in New York City....that's really gettin' around. And I understand you been cuttin' a few records, too.

BILLY: Well...you know how it is.

ERNEST: You've got a great one out now, Billy. I wonder if you'd mind doing it for the folks?

BILLY: Be glad to, Ernest.

ERNEST: Here he is, Neighbors...Billy Grammer...with one of his big Monument discs called....."The Kissin' Tree". BILLY GRAMMER!

TUBB: Well, Grant... <sup>you know</sup> spring is really with us down here, and it won't be long before most men will be workin' outdoors !

(APPLAUSE & PLAYOFF)

TUBB: Say, Archie...<sup>kyching way</sup> do you smoke?

ARCHIE: ~~Yes...and~~ sometimes I get so hot ~~under the collar~~ I even burn.

TUBB: No, no, Archie...I mean...do you smoke a pipe?

ARCHIE: Ohhhhh,..smoke a pipe? Now I get it. ~~It's not you're snoopin'~~ <sup>tryin'</sup> around to get me to say somethin' about Prince Albert Smokin' Tobacco.

TUBB: AD LIBS BRIEFLY ABOUT FUTURE TOURS

GRANT: Sounds like a lot of miles, Ernest. But now how about a song ' Here he is, neighbors.....Ernest Tubb...with his own latest Decca record....."I'D RATHER BE".

MUSIC: "HERE AND THERE"...T. JACKSON...FADE UNDER AS BG FOR :
