FARON:

Glad to be here, Grant...glad to be here. And I sure am pleased and happy that so many out there have joined us for the Grand Ole Opry. We got a great list of entertainers for tonight's show....so Grant...how about you tellin' the Folks?

GRANT:

Be glad to, Faron. First off...there's Cousin Minnie Pearl and Boob Brasfield.

FARON:

Yes...and Grandpa Jones...

GRANT:

... Del Wood... Tommy Jackson... Ralph Sloan... and the

Tennessee Travelers....

(FARON OVER)

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.... and as our special guests... those great entertainers...

TEDDY AND DOYLE... THE WILBURN BROTHERS!!

APPLAUSE

FARON:

We'll be havin' some great songs from Teddy and Doyle in just a little while. Right now it's my pleasure to welcome to the Opry one of the really great comics of our time... Boob Brasfield!

APPLAUSE & PLAY ON

BOOB'S ROUTINE

APPLAUSE & PLAY OFF

FARON:

Thank you, Boob Brasfield...it's always a pleasure to have you with us. Which brings us down to "guest time" on the show... so let's have a great big Grand Ole Opry welcome for those two good lookin' Wilburn Boys....Teddy and Doyle!!

APPLAUSE

FARON:

Teddy...Doyle...welcome to the show. It's been quite a spell since I laid eyes on either of you.

TEDDY:

Well...you know we just got back a few weeks ago from a trip to Australia.

DOYLE:

Yeah...and this is the first time since then we've been on this part of the show.

(FARON OVER)

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Well, it's real good to have you back. Tell me somethin'...did you boys bring me any present from Australia?

DOY LE:

Well, Grant... like to stick around the house quite a bit. Atake in a ballgame once in a white... fish a little and just generally do nothin!.

(GRANT OVER)

GRANT:

You sound like a man who likes his comfort,

FARON:

That really put some pep and ginger into things, Faron...but

now what do you say to a "change of pace"... as we slow the

tempo down a little while you sing one of those great religious

songs you do so well,

MUSIC: CUE:

SNEAK IN UNDERSCORE AS FARON GOES RIGHT ON:

FARON:

Thank you, Grant...for those kind words. This next song is one

of my favorites...(AD LIBS BRIEFLY ABOUT TUNE...THEN

INTRODUCES IT).

MUSIC:

'WHEN I'VE LEARNED".....FARON YOUNG

APPLAUSE

FARON:

Thank you, ... thank you, Thanks so very much, You're a

wonderful audience.

GRANT:

It was a great song, Faron...the kind I really like.

FARON:

Well speaking of liking something... I know everybody is gonna

like out next entertainer. He's been around the Grand Ole

Opry just about as often as anybody I can remember, and he

newer fails to please the crowd. Here he is... your friend and :

mine....Grandpa Jones!!

APPLAUSE

(MUSIC...GRAND PA.. OVER)

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MUSIC:

"ARE YOU FROM DIXIE"... GRAND PA JONES

APPLAUSE

FARON:

"Are you From Dixie"... Grandpa Jones and the old five-string Thanks a lot Grandpa. You sure do whip that thing. But now... things are really beginnin' to get bigger and better than ever. Without another word...it's my pleasure to introduce the girl who can talk longer...and faster...and say LESS...than anybody I know.....COUSIN MINNIE PEARL!

APPLAUSE & PLAY ON

MINNIE'S ROUTINE

APPLAUSE & PLAY OFF

FARON:

Samuel Nest Hey, Minnie! I hear your cousin Deedie got married the other day. I thought she was in love with Sam Purtie!

MINNIE:

Oh, she was. Sam was Deedie's "dream man"... but this other fellow was wide awake...an' proposed.

FARON:

I'll bet you/he smokes Prince Albert.

'WHIRLAWAY".....DELWOOD

APPLAUSE

FARON:

Thank you, Miss Del..., thanks just more than we can say.

That was extra special.

GRANT:

It certainly was, Faron...but now everybody wants to hear that

extra special new record you cut just a while ago. But before

the singin'..., haven't you got anything to tell the folks?

FARON:

Well Grant.... I want to thank them for bein' so nice to all of

us.

GRANT:

What about your coming tour?

FARON:

Oh...yes...I almost forgot. (AD LIBS BRIEFLY ABOUT NEXT

TRIP).

GRANT:

And the best of Juck, Faron. Now...it's time for that song.

Faron Young, Neighbors..., with his latest Capitol record...

'We're Talking It Over".

MUSIC:

'WE'RE TALKING IT OVER".....FARON YOUNG

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FARON:

Well Neighbors...it's time for us to leave you. Sure was nice havin' you here with us at The Grand Ole Opry tonight. Listen next week,...won't you,...when Cowboy Copas will be headin' up the show with Hank Locklin along as his guest. Till then...this is Faron Young sayin'...Thanks...and we'll be seein' you NEXT week,...at....THE GRAND...OLE...OPRY!!
