GRANT: By all means, Ernest,, and you might tell 'em about the great show we've got lined up.

ERNEST: That's your job, Grant,,, that's your job.

GRANT: Well,,,, first off,,, aside from Ernest and ALL the Texas Troubadors,, we've got comedy star,, Cousin Minnie Pearl,,, along with that funny man,, Archie Campbell.

GRANT: ...Miss Del Wild, Tommy Jackson... Ben Smathers and the

ERNEST: Thank you, Archie...thanks a lot, I reckon now you can get
on back to Bulls Gap and take things easy. Which brings us right
down to "guest time"...on the show...and we certainly have
got a good one this evening. A young man who has spent the
bulk of his life in the entertainment business. Let's make him
feel real at home here at the Opry...SONNY JAMES!

ERNEST: Sonny..., it's certainly a pleasure to have you here tonight.

SONNY: That goes double for me, Ernest.

ERNEST: Sonny..., I wasn't kidding when I said you'd been in the entertainment business most of you life..., and I want you to answer a big question for me.

SONNY: If I can, Ernest.

ERNEST: What was your biggest thrill? What part of the work did you get your biggest kick out of?

SONNY: That's hard to say, Ernest. Some time back I cut a record for the Capitol people..., and when we knew it was gonna be a hit..., I sure felt good.

ERNEST: And that record was.....

GRANT: Ernest Tubb, ladies and gentlemen, . . , along with all The Troubadors, . . . , singing that great hymn, . . . , "The Ole Rugged Cross"

MUSIC: "THE OLD RUGGED CROSS".....ERNEST TUBB

APPLAUSE

ERNEST: Thank you, . . , thank you, You're very kind. It's a pleasure to sing for you. And it's a pleasure to listen to the fine music of our next entertainer. Here he is, . . , Chet Atkins playin', . . . , "Steel Guitar Rag".

ERNEST: *Sam* Minnie...Hezzy acts awful mad, ~~What's the matter with him?~~

MINNIE: He thinks he's been cheated. He bought a thousand pins for
a dime...but when he counted 'em...there was three short.

(ERNEST OVER)
