ROY: It's a pleasure to be here, Grant Turner...and may I in turn extend a great big welcome to all the good folks who have joined us on this warm Fourth of July evening ?

GRANT: You most certainly may, Roy...and I want to be the first to tell them about the great show lined up for tonight !

ROY: By all means, Grant !

GRANT: First off...we're honored by the presence of one of my favorites, Miss June Carter....
