Records... "Our Song Of Love." Welcome, Porter.
Welcome... to the Grand Ole Opry. We've got a great show
lined up for tonight, including such great Opry personalities
as Cousin Minnie Pearl... Archie Campbell... Chet Atkins...
Stringbean... Tommy Jackson and his fiddle... Ralph Sloan
and the Tennessee Travelers... and as our special guest...
that boy with the ragged britches and the big broad grin on
his face..... COUSIN JODY !!

GRANT: Archie Campbell, Ladies and Gentlemen,...and a great entertainer he is. Thank you, Archie, thanks a lot. Now Porter.....

PORTER: What's on your mind, Grant?

GRANT: Don't you think it's about time we introduced our guest?

PORTER: Go right ahead, Grant,..go right ahead.

GRANT: Well, neighbors...our next guest really doesn't need any introduction....he's come to be sort of an institution around the Grand Ole Opry.....so let's hear a great big welcome for....Cousin Jody...and all his gang !
