APPLAUSE

MUSIC: "DON'T TELL ME YOUR TROUBLES".....DON GIBSON

APPLAUSE

GRANT: Don Gibson,, The Golden Boy,, with one of his latest RCA Victor records,, "Don't Tell Me Your Troubles". Thank you, Don,, and welcome to The Grand Ole Opry. We've got a regular "star studded" show lined up for tonight including such Grand Ole Opry greats as Cousin Minnie Pearl,, Archie Campbell,, Chet Atkins,, Grandpa Jones,, Tommy Jackson,, Ralph Sloan and those great dancers The Tennessee Travelers,, and as our special guest we've got that smilin', happy boy who hails from down Louisiana way,, Jimmy,,,,, Newman!!

APPLAUSE

(GRANT OVER)

GRANT: We'll be listening to one of Jimmy's great songs in just a few minutes. Right now it's time we heard from that wise man who once said... "To have a short summer... arrange to have one of your car notes come due in early September!" ...the sage of Bulls Gap, Tennessee... ARCHIE CAMPBELL!

APPLAUSE & PLAY ON

ARCHIE'S ROUTINE

APPLAUSE & PLAY OFF

GRANT: Archie Campbell, ladies and gentlemen... and all I can say is that it shouldn't happen to a nicer man. Thank you, Archie... thanks a lot. Which brings us down to "guest time" on the show. ... so let's have a great big "Opry" welcome for my good friend and yours..... JIMMY.....  
NEWMAN !!

APPLAUSE

GRANT: Jimmy... Don and myself are happy as a lark about havin' you here on the show with us.

JIMMY: And I'm happy to be here... so that makes three of us that are glad.

(DON OVER)

DON: To say nothin' of all those people out there, James, They're glad you're here too.

GRANT: And they'll be even happier when you sing one of your great new MGM recordings, Jimmy...so how about it, Jimmy...we're ready any time you are.

JIMMY: That's the best offer I've had today, Grant...so if the boys are ready...let's take off on a little tune called... "Grin And Bear It",

APPLAUSE

MUSIC: NEWMAN....."GRIN AND BEAR IT"

APPLAUSE

DON: Say, Grant,<sup>Turner</sup> the last time I was on the show you gave me some advice about pipe smoking,

GRANT: So I did, Donald,<sup>well</sup> Did it work out all right?

GRANT: Well then...how about the title song from that great album of sacred songs and hymns that you recorded for RCA Victor a while back?

MUSIC: CUE: SNEAK IN UNDERSCORE...SOFTLY ...AS GRANT GOES ON:

GRANT: You know, Neighbors...some of these songs Don learned as a youngster goin' to church in his native North Carolina hills...some he wrote himself...and some he selected from the works of other great song writers. Anyway...here he is with the one I like best... 'Where No One Stands Alone',

MUSIC: 'WHERE NO ONE STANDS ALONE'...DON GIBSON

APPLAUSE

(DON OVER)

DON: Thank you...thank you ever so much, Folks. It always makes me feel real good to sing for you here on the Opry. And I'll tell you somethin' else that makes me feel good, It's introducin' a great musician and a fine friend...that master of the electric guitar...Chet Atkins...playin' ...."San Antonio Rose"!

APPLAUSE

MUSIC: "SAN ANTONIO ROSE".....CHET ATKINS

APPIAUSE

DON: Chet Atkins and "San Antonio Rose"...and a wonderful job you did with it, Chet. Thanks a lot. But don't go 'way, Folks...because the show gets better and better. If you don't believe me...just listen while Grant says.....

GRANT: Now here's one of The Grand Ole Opry Greats...that bouncy girl from Grinders Switch...Cousin Minnie Pearl!

GRANT: Jimmy Newman singin' "Jambalya". Thank you, Jimmy... and thanks so much for bein' the guest on the show tonight. It was a real pleasure.

DON: That's for sure, Jimmy, but now Grant... how about introducing our next performer?

GRANT: Just gettin' around to it, Don. Neighbors... Don was speakin' of one of our Opry featured performers who plays the fire out of a five string banjo and sings the daylight out of a song... so here he is... Grandpa Jones and "Eight More Miles To Louisville!"

DON: Okay by me, Grant,..but what do you have on your mind?

GRANT: Don,..everybody is interested in what a big star like you  
does,..so tell us a little about your future plans.

DON: Well Grant,..there's not much to tell,..(AD LIBS BRIEFLY  
ABOUT TOUR DATES AND FUTURE RECORDING DATES)

GRANT: Well, good luck,..and good fortune, Don. Now,..how about  
singin' a song, Neighbors,..here's Don Gibson with that  
great new ballad he cut for RCA Victor,..,"Heartbreak  
Avenue"!

MUSIC: "FORKED DEER"...T. JACKSON...FADE UNDER AS BG FOR:

show because Roy Acuff,..Mr. Country Music himself,..  
will be on,..and will have Stonewall Jackson along as his  
guest. Now,..this is Don Gibson sayin',..thanks,..and we'll
