MUSIC: "UNCLE PEN"..... PORTER WAGONER

(APPLAUSE)

CO BB: Porter Wagoner and all the boys with "Uncle Pen"...that great tune Porter recorded sometime back. Welcome, Porter... welcome to the Grand (le (pry. We been missin' you a round here. Where you been?

PORTER: (hhhh...out on the road...makin' personals.

CO BB: Well...you're back here on the show tonight and that's all that counts. And we have got a great show lined up for this evening. Yessir. There's Archie Campbell...and The Jordanaires....

PORTER: Sound mighty good so far.

CO BB: Then our good buddy Chet Atkins...Miss Del Wood... Tommy Jackson...Ralph Stan and all the Tennessee Travelers...

(PORTER (VER)

PORTER: Sounds better all the time, Dave.

COBB: And to top things off in a really big way... as special guest, we've got that all-time (pry favorite...CARL SMITH !

(APPLAUSE)

COBB: We'll be talkin' to Carl and hearin' one of his great songs in just a few minutes. Right now it's time we listened to these wonderful entertainers and crowd pleasin' spiritual singers, The Jordanaires, as they favor us with one of the great songs from their forthcoming Capitol Album...."One of These Mornings."

(APPLAUSE)

MUSIC: "ONE OF THESE MORNINGS".....THE JORDANAIRES

(APPLAUSE)

COBB: The Jordanaires, and "One of These Mornings". Thank you, boys....that was wonderful. And stick around while we welcome our guest, (TO CROWD) Let's have a big , big welcome for your friend and mine....CARL SMITH !!

(APPLAUSE)

COBB: Carl ... Porter and I both want to extend our welcome and say thanks for comin' down here to the (pry.

(CARL COVER)

CARL: It's always a pleasure to come back to the Ryman and the Grand C le C pry, Dave. Porter...you're lookin' good.

PORTER: So are you, Carl...but let's not waste any time in talkin' ..let's let the folks hear that great new Columbia record of yours.

CARL: You mean the one where all the drummers in town get a job?

CLUBB: That's the one, Carl...all ten thousand of 'em.

(APPLAUSE)

MUSIC: "TEN THOUSAND DRUMS".....CARL SMITH

(APPLAUSE)

PORTER: *ninety, ninety five* That's a fine song, Carl, but *by the way* before you get too far away, *your* tell me a little about that new farm of yours.

CARL: *well* It's great, Porter, but if it's all the same, I'd like to tell you a little about Prince Albert Smokin' Tobacco...and how good it is in a pipe .

CC BB: By all means....by all means.

MUSIC CUE: SNEAK IN UNDERSCORE...SOFTLY AS PORTER GOES RIGHT ON.

PORTER: The other day, I got a chance to walk out alone in the woods where I was far away from the sight and sound of our everyday living. And there, alone in the forrest, I couldn't help but be struck with the wonder of it all... and a great feeling of awe and reverence. And thru my mind kept running the words and music of this song.

(APPLAUSE)

CC BB: Porter Wagoner and..."I Thought of God". Thank you, Porter...for that inspiring song. Which brings us down to the spot on the show where we introduce a great guitar player, who...I think sometimes...is inspired himself. Chet Atkins...playing..."Humoresque."

MUSIC: "HUMORESQUE".....CHET ATKINS

(CC BB (VER)


