JAME Ohhhhasas

JIMMY Goshs

TOM Quiet...no use gotting excited...

REPEAT WAILING

WRANGLER Good heavens, Tom....it sonds the chills right up my

JAME (LOW) Jimmy ... hold my hand ..

JIMMY (LOW) All right sis...but don't cry...

JAME (LOW) I won't...

TOM Can't seem to figure where it's coming from.

WRANGLER Up shead...I think...but let's get out of here Tom..

this aint no place for us... I aint equipped to

handle ghosts..

TOM We're staying here...Jane and Jimmy...you better go

outside the cavern and wait by the horsesee

JIMMY But ...

TOM Now obey me...run along now..

JIMMY All right ... come on sis.

an echo..

BUSINESS: WALKING ON GRAVEL AS KIDS FADE OUT)

WRANGLER What do you make of it Tom?

TOM I don't believe in ghosts...and this doesn't sound like

WRANGLER Doggone it Tom...you don't believe there's some one here...making that swful noise...

BUSINESS: WAILING SOUND AGAIN

WRANGLER Tom... this aint natural at all...

TOM Come ahead with me...slow now...it's up by the waterhead..

WRANGLER I don't know what good it'll do...but I'm drawing my gun..

TOM Keep your eyes sharp and look in every crevice..

WRANGLER All right...but it's getting darker and darker...

TOM It takes on ornery cuss to make a sound like that...

WRANGLER I sint so sure if it is a ornery cuss Tome.

TOM Watch it Wranglers

WRANGLER Holy smokes...some one's dug a big hole here...

TOM If you fell into that...it would mean sure donth...
you'd drown...

WRANGLER Tom ... if you hadn't held me back...I'd a been a goner by now...

That's funny...this hole's been freshly dug...now don't tell me a ghost did that...

TOM

Hurry before he gets out...

WRANGLE

Before who gets out? You're talking loss now ..

TOM

Before that ornery cuss gets out...he's got some

secret passageway in this covern on the other side

of the wall. that's the only emplanation for it..

come one

WRANGLER

Oh. such a mess. such a messe

BUSINESS: WAILING VERY FAINT.

TOM

Hurry Wrangler...before he gets out...hurry..

BUSINESS: SOUND OF RUNNING OVER GRAVEL

TOM

Hurry .. burry

THE FROM OUTSIDE THERE COMES THE SHRILL CRY OF THE KIDS

WRANGLER Tom....Jane and Jimmy ... outside ... trouble.

TOM

Run. come on

FROM OUTSIDE A GAIN COMES THE CRY OF THE KIDS YELLING AND CALLING

WRANGERL Sun's down .. cm't see a thinge...

TOM

There they are...hosses jumping in the air..scared.

JIMY

(UP) (SORT OF SCARED AND TEMBE) Tome. Tome. a man.

orme out from behind that rock...he looked awfults:

JAK

His face ... all green ... and he threw rocks at our

hosses.

TOM

Whon .. whon ... Tony ... whon .. Queenie.

TOM Nove... you sure Jimmy ... bout that men?

JIMMY Yes. . Tom. . . he came out right from behind that rock

there...and I know his face was all gross...and

his tooth showing ... and gosh ... it made my skin get

kinda cold.

WRANGLER Tom. .. listons

TOM I hear it..

SOUND OF HOOVES AWAY ... GALLOPPING OFF

WRANGLER Don't forget to tell our straight shooters how to get those four dandy presents from Tom Mix...especially the big new book which tells all about Tom's life-and which has that interesting diagram showing all the places Tom has been injured, (CONTINUED OVER)

WRANGLER

(CONTINUES) and shot in his dealings with outlawsand in doing those heir raising stunts you see him

AMMOUNCER:
