WRANGLER: What do you reckon we better do, Tom?

TOM: C'mon Wrangler, we're headin' fer the Badland Hills...

to see what's up with Jane and Jimmy ...

WRANGLER: O.K... Tom.... Comon .. git ... giddap....

(SOUND OF HORSES HOOFS FADING AND THEN RETURNING)

TOM: Trail don't seem to go much further.

WRANGLER: I dunno... I never been this way before...

TOM: Wrangler ... See that old shack down there ...

WRANGLER: Yep, Tom ... Only building we passed on this here trail.

TON: Mebbe that's what we're looking for.

WRANGLER: It was a barn once, I reckon... That ud be a good place

to hide the cow

TOM: Look Wrangler! Say! I think we're near!!

WRANGLER: Why, Tom? Why?

TOM: Those marks in the clay.... horses hoofs.

WRANGLER: People have been here just a little while ago ...

TOM: Jane and Jimmy, mebbe.. I reckon we've found them...

WRANGLER: Thank the lucky stars fer that.

TOM: Let's leave the horses here ... walk to the shack ...

WRANGLER: O.K. Tom... Whoa thar!....

(SOUND OF HORSES COMES TO A STOP)

TOM: Walk quiet, Wrangler.. can't tell how many are in that

shack.

WRANGLER: You bet... mebbe a whul gang....

TOM: Look.... see that loose board over there... let's lift it

up...

WRANGLER: And peek into the shack, eh? ... Good idee.

TOM: Listen... I hear voices inside!

WRANGLER: Jiminy, so do I .. git your gun ready ..

TOM: Someone banging on the door ...

WRANGLER: Fasy now... liftin' up that loose board...

TOM: Here she goes... now I'll peek in... Well I'LL BF....

WRANGLER: What's the matter, Tom? What do you see?

TOM: Knock me over with a feather! It's Jane and Jimmy!

WRANGLER: Jumping coyotes, Tom! ... How many's with 'em?

TOM: How many what?

WRANGLER: Ain't they caught by a gang.. let me look... Jiminy!

They're all alone.

TOM: They're trying to open the big door ... c'mon around ...

WRANGLER: There's the lock on it....

TOM: (UNLOCKING DOOR) O.K... now let's pull it open....

(SOUND OF DOOR OPENING)

WRANGLER: Heave! ... There she goes!

TOM: Hullo kids!..

JIMMY: Tom! and Wrangler!

JANF: Oh Tom., it's so good you came to get us....

JIMMY: How did you know where we were?

TOM: We jest followed the hill trail....

WRANGLER: We waited at the ranch and when you didn't come back...

we went after you ...

TOM: I see you found the cow....

WRANGLER: Not a big cow is she... but all Mrs. Mallory's got.

I reckon....

JIMMY: We found her right off ... just rode along the trail to

this shack.

JANF: And when we looked in... there she was!...

TOM: But Jane.., who locked you in?

WRANGLER: Yes... was they the ones who stole the cow?

JIMMY: There wasn't any gang ... only one kid from school

TOM: Kid from school!....

JANF: Yes... Nicky McGee... the bully... He stole Mrs. Mallory's

COW.

JDMY: And he hid her here so's he could find her... and then

JIMMY: He thinks that'll win him the Good Deed Medal...

TOM: Reckon it will if the teacher believes his story

WRANGLER: Well... we can take care of that now

TOM: You bet ... We'll tell your teacher Mr. Hendricks .. that

you two kids set out to find that cow

JANE: Yes... He'll believe you Tom .. and Mrs. Mallory can prove

we couldn't have been in the Badlands when she saw us

down here with you....

JIMMY: We better find Mr. Hendricks though before Nick makes

up a fake story to tell him

TOM: I figger it's o.k. to leave the cow here for the time

bein' ... we'll come back for it later

WRANGLER: Yep.. main thing now is to get back to town... and

clear you two kids

TOM: Here's our horses... let's ride fast.. back to town...

JIMMY: C'mon giddap King... git..

JANF: .Come on Queenie...

(SOUND OF HORSES FADING AND THEN RETURNING)

JIMMY: Hey Tom... Tom...

TOM: Yes, Jimmy?

JIMMY: Supposin' Mr. Hendricks doesn't believe Jane an' me are

innocent?

JANF: Oh Jimmy... he'll have to believe it...

WRANGLER: It's the word of all four of us and Mrs. Mallory ...

against that one McGee kid that's been mixed up in a lot of

ornery business before.

TOM: That's true.. I don't think you need to worry Jimmy

unless...

JIMMY: Unless what?

TOM: Well ... unless that Nicky McGee thinks up some other

stunt to put you and Jane in bad

JANE: It wouldn't surprise me, Tom ... if he did ... Nicky is smar

when it comes to doin' tricky things

WRANGLER: Say! ... Down the road there! See who's coming....

TOM: I reckon we don't need to ride to town to get him....

it's Mr. Hendricks ... your teacher ...

JANE: Gosh.,. that's who it is!

JIMMY: Coming up here.. to find out about us stealing the cow!

TOM: Now don't worry kids ... we'll fix everything up...

just tell the truth and you'll come out all right.....

JIMMY: Gosh I'd like to beat up that sneak Nicky McGee

WRANGLER: Here's Teacher Hendricks now --

(SOUND OF HORSE'S HOOFS COMING TO A HALT)

TOM: Hullo Mr. Hendricks.... looking for us...

WRANGLER: Howdy Teacher Hendricks...

HENDRICKS: Why hullo Tom Mix ... and Wrangler .. hullo Jane and Jimmy ...

JIMMY: Good morning Mr. Hendricks...

JANE: Hullo Teacher...

HENDRICKS: Are you children having a nice Saturday off?

JANE: Oh yes...

HFMDRICKS: Well.. be sure to have your homework ready for Monday ...

JIMMY: Gosh yes.. Mr. Hendricks .. we always do.. I finished

that 'rithmetic problem you gave us already ...

HENDRICKS: That's fine Jimmy er., I'll tell you why I came over ..

WRANGLER: Reckon we know...

TOM: Was it about Mrs. Mallory's cow?

JIMMY: Yes ... cause if it was ... then me and Jane

really didn't have anything to --

HENDRICKS: Cow? No I don't know anything about a cow?

What was there about a cow?

JIMMY: Well... just that Jane and I found one that was stolen ...

HENDRICKS: Good for you.. that's fine.. only -- well er ...

TOM: What's the matter Mr. Hendrickst ...

HENDRICKS: Well... that business about the cow ... makes it even

harder to say what I came to ask

WRANGLER: What's that, Teacher Hendricks?

HENDRICKS: I couldn't believe it .. I don't now .. but still .. er .. I

TOM: Well., tell us,.,

HENDRICKS: I found this note on my desk this morning.... a little

while ago ...

TOM: I'll read it out loud to the rest of you....

WRANGLER: Who gave it to you?

HEMDRICKS: It's not signed. so I don't know for sure...

TOM: Holy smoke! Listen to this....

HENDRICKS: I know., it's an awful accusation....

TOM: It says ... "Dear Mr. Hendricks: The new football

equipment for the school team is missing.

(MORE)

(TOM - CONTINUED)

The thieves who stole it are Jane and Jimmy.... They've got the stuff at their ranch house now... Signed -- One of your pupils...

WRANGLER:

Well ... I'll be ----...

JIMMY:

We stole the new football stuff!

JANE:

Oh Mr. Hendricks.. that's not true.. that's not true!!!!

HENDRICKS:

When I looked in the cloakroom closet.. all the new

equipment that the School Board bought us -- was gone!!!

TOME

And you think Jane and Jimmy took them?

HENDRICKS:

Why no.. I don't believe that of course.. but this note ...

TOM:

Sure.. I understand ...

HENDRICKS:

You're manager of the team, aren't you, Jimmy?

JIMMY:

Yessir... and I was the only one besides you with the

key to that closet

HEMORICKS:

Yes, I know that ... so naturally I figured I'd better

ride over here....

TOM:

Sure.. the proof is on Jane and Jimmy

JANE:

Oh this is awful ... us being accused of stealing school

property!

JIMMY:

Don't worry sis .. we'll prove we're not the crooks ..

HENDRICKS:

Of course you will, Jane .. I don't believe for one

minute my best two students would do such a thing.. but ..

well ...

WRANGLER:

Sure, Teacher Hendricks.. naturally you had to investigate.

TOM

Tell you what .. suppose we all go into the ranch house ..

the note says the football stuff is hidden there

HENDRICKS:

That's what I thought .. And if it isn't there.. well ..

Jane and Jimmy baven't anything to do with it

JIMMY: We'l

We'll look in all my bureau drawers, Mr. Hendricks.. I'll

show you it's not there.

JANE:

And not in my room either ..

HENDRICKS:

All right, children... just don't worry.... It'll take

more than an unsigned note for me to doubt you two....

TOM:

Let's go into the house, shall we?

(SOUND OF WALKING FOR A FEW MOMENTS)

JIMMY:

This is my room here....

WRANGLER:

Say! ... you sure keep it tidy, Jimmy

TOM:

No sign of football equipment under the bed....

JIMMY:

Here.. I'll open these bureau drawers... (OPEN DRAWER)

Not in the top one...

JANE:

Try the next drawer, Jimmy

JIMMY:

O.K. sis. (OPFNS DRAWER) Oh say!

JANE:

It's THERE! ...

TOM:

Well I'll be ...! Every bit of it ... all stuck in there!

WRANGLER:

Jumping coyotes! Howd it get there!...

HENDRICKS:

Jane and Jimmy ... I'm sorry this had to happen

JANE:

(NEAR TEARS) Oh honest, Mr. Hendricks, we didn't do it ...

we didn't

JIMMY:

Someone put it in there.. I didn't ... really I didn't.

HENTRICKS:

Oh now don't get too upset .. If you can prove you're

not guilty Jimmy ... I'll be the first to say you couldn't

have done it.

WRANGLER:

Jane and Jimmy have been framed, that's what!

HENDRICKS:

Framed is an ugly word, Wrangler.

TOM:

Sure... Teacher Hendricks is right.. First Jimmy has got

to prove he's not the thief

HPMDRICKS: Jimmy... you solve this theft.. it's up to you.. someone

stole the school team equipment ... when you find out who,

then let me know ... otherwise ...

JIMMY: Yes I know, teacher ... then otherwise you'll have to

figger that I did it

HENDRICKS: I can hardly believe that of you.... still this note...

and then finding the stuff hidden here Well ... ere

... I'll ride home and you come to me when you've solved

all this ...

(DOOR CLOSES)

JANF: Gosh Tom... Tom.. what are we gonna do?

JIMMY: Who could have planted this stuff here?

JANE: Gee ... I.. I never was suspected before ...

TOM: Now cheer up, Jane ... ve'll find a way out ... I can't

blame Mr. Hendricks

JIMMY: No... He knows some one did it.. and right now he can't

be blamed for thinking it's us....

WRANGLER: Mighty funny .. the way it happens right on top of Mrs.

Mallory's stolen cow ...

TOM: Well.... I figger the two thefts are linked together ...

JIMMY: What do you mean, Tom?

JANE: Do you think that ---?

TOM: Well, look ... Nick McGee rode back to town to tell Mr.

Hendricks that you and Jane had stolen the cow and that

he had you locked in the barn where it was ..

WRANGLER: And on the way he passed Tom and me...

TOM

That's right... He knew by the time he brought the teacher back to the old barn in Badland Hills... why Wrangler and me would set you two free.... and his frame-up wouldn't be any good...

JIMMY:

I see! I see what you mean, Tom!

JANE:

Then he thought of this other trick!

TOM:

(MORF)

(ANNOUNCER - CONTINUED)

Nicky McGee is the school bully.... He wants to win that Good Deed contest that Mr. Hendricks is running.... and Nicky will do anything to keep Jimmy and Jane from winning.. First he tried to frame them with Mrs. Mallory's stolen cow.. but when that fell through then he -- or somebody -- framed them with the school football equipment, by hiding it in Jimmy's room....

WRANGLER:

Let's hope the kids are cleared next time! That feller McGee is jest about as ornery as they makes em. Now on Friday you'll find out just what happened. And you can bet your last bouquet o tumbleweed 'n buffalo grass, that McGee is gonna wish he'd try to win the Good Deed medal honorably. Remember that, will you straight shooters? About playing the game fair and square.
